## INTRODUCTION

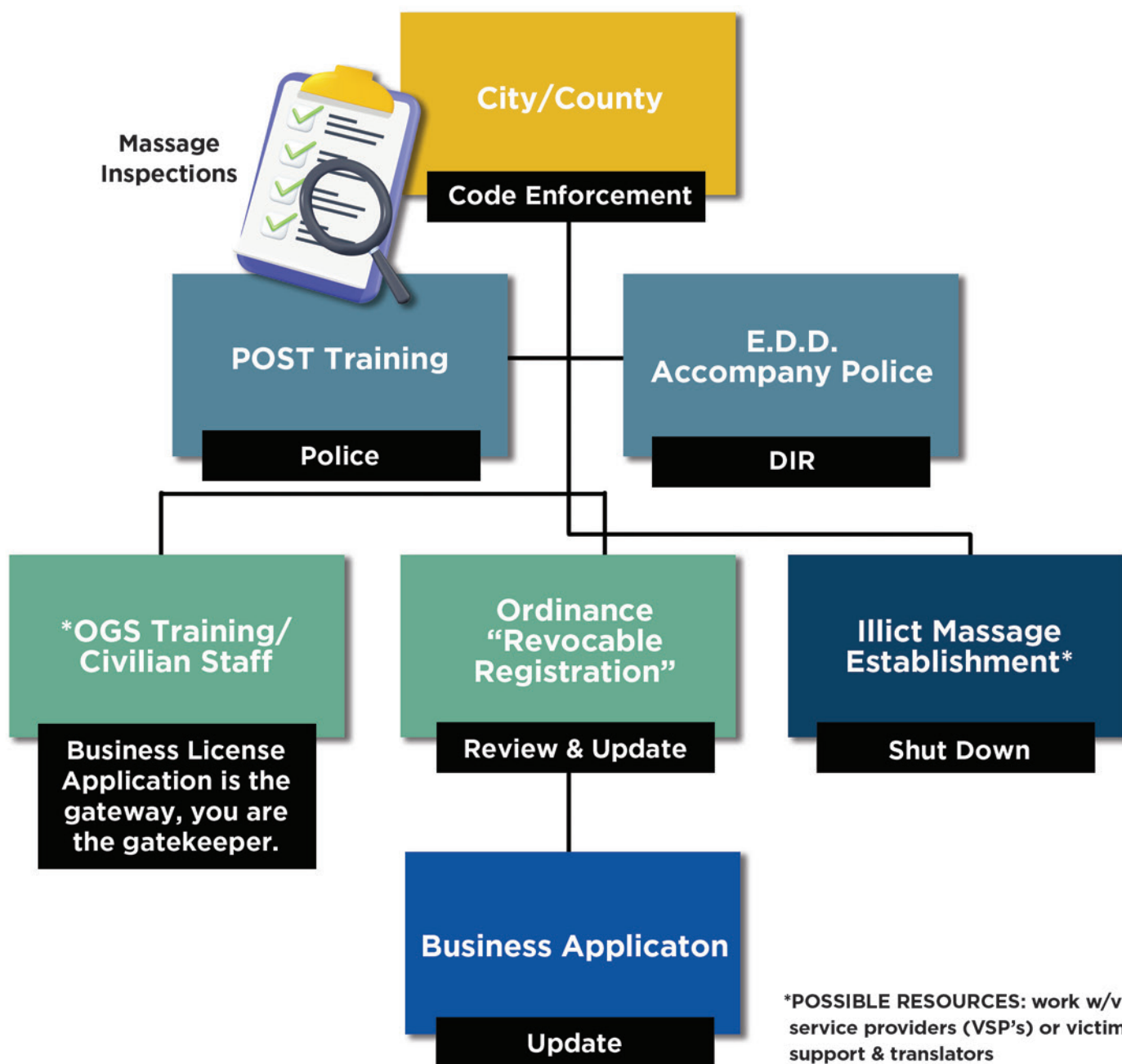

# CAMTC's Suggested Path to Eliminate Human Trafficking in Massage

CAMTC has a long history of working with cities and counties to make suggestions for proposed changes to their ordinances, which incorporate best practices used by other jurisdictions that take aim at illicit massage establishments, while treading lightly on legitimate massage professionals.

This is a difficult balance to strike, and we are always striving to incorporate new suggested changes that get us all closer to this important goal of eliminating human trafficking from massage.

California Business and Professions Code section 4603.1 requires that: “Local governments shall impose and enforce only reasonable and necessary fees and regulations on massage businesses and massage establishments, in keeping with the requirements of existing Law and being mindful of the need to protect legitimate business owners and massage professionals, particularly sole providers.”

As a practical matter, we usually insert comments and suggestions directly into your existing ordinance in different colors, so you can easily distinguish comments from inserted provisions of ordinances from other jurisdictions.

The following are five components that CAMTC observes in the most successful jurisdictions that are eliminating human trafficking in massage.

- **STEP 1:** Schedule your police and code enforcement officers to attend CAMTC's free 2-hour POST approved Zoom Training, held each month. The attendees will learn how to easily collect evidence of illicit massage activity to aid in closing down that illicit establishment.
- **STEP 2:** Schedule your civilian staff, working the front counter issuing massage business licenses/establishment permits, to attend CAMTC's free 2-hour **Operation Get Smart** Zoom Training that's held each month.
- **STEP 3:** Schedule a free massage ordinance review by our statewide expert, who will suggest changes so you can update your ordinance to current standards and drive out human trafficking in massage from your city.
- **STEP 4:** Review Sunnyvale's recommended 9-page business license application, (see **Sample Application Forms** below), that becomes your firewall to accomplish two goals:
  - First, to thwart the traffickers before they can establish an illicit massage business
    - saving your city \$1,000's of police and code enforcement investigative costs.
  - Second, if the trafficker is already embedded in your city, you can remove them in a timely manner avoiding costly and time-consuming Red Light Abatement costs.
- **STEP 5:** Use CAMTC as a resource for CAMTC Certified individuals when conducting enforcement of your Municipal Code and California State Law. If your city does not require CAMTC Certification, make sure you are checking CAMTC's "**Verify Certification**" at <https://www.camtc.org/law-enforcement-government-agencies/> to ensure you are not issuing city permits to individuals that CAMTC has denied or taken disciplinary action. **Dynamically sharing information between your city and CAMTC, is imperative for lasting results.**

# Program Administration

## Licenses and Permits Staff

- Point of contact with businesses
- Receive application and fees, review applications for accuracy
- Investigate application documents, background information and web presence of all applicants
- Issue permits and amendments, maintain all records
- Schedule inspections, review inspection reports
- Initiate discipline for failed inspections, follow up on complaints
- Participate in department hearings and appeal hearings



# Program Administration (cont.)

## Neighborhood Preservation (Code Enforcement)

- Conduct annual and semi-annual inspections, create inspection reports
- Reinspect for correction of violations

## Investigations Detectives

- Follow up on complaints of criminal activity, conduct undercover operations
- Participate in department hearings and appeal hearings

## Office of the City Attorney

- Provide advice on discipline notices and enforcement activities
- Represent the city in department hearings and appeal hearings

# Application Forms

## Up to 60 Day Process

### Who

- For **EACH OWNER**
  - 5 years of employment/residence information
  - Other or previous owned massage businesses
- Corporations, LLC, and Fictitious Name documents
- All owners and employees are identified with color photo ID, CAMTC Certification or fingerprinting

### What

- Mirrors SMC requirements
- Must be amended if anything in the application changes (including add/remove employees)
- Owner certifies under penalty of perjury that all information is true and correct

### How

- All information in an application is verified
- Outreach to partner agencies to verify information that is in the application
- Query other law enforcement agencies about criminal history
- Premises are inspected

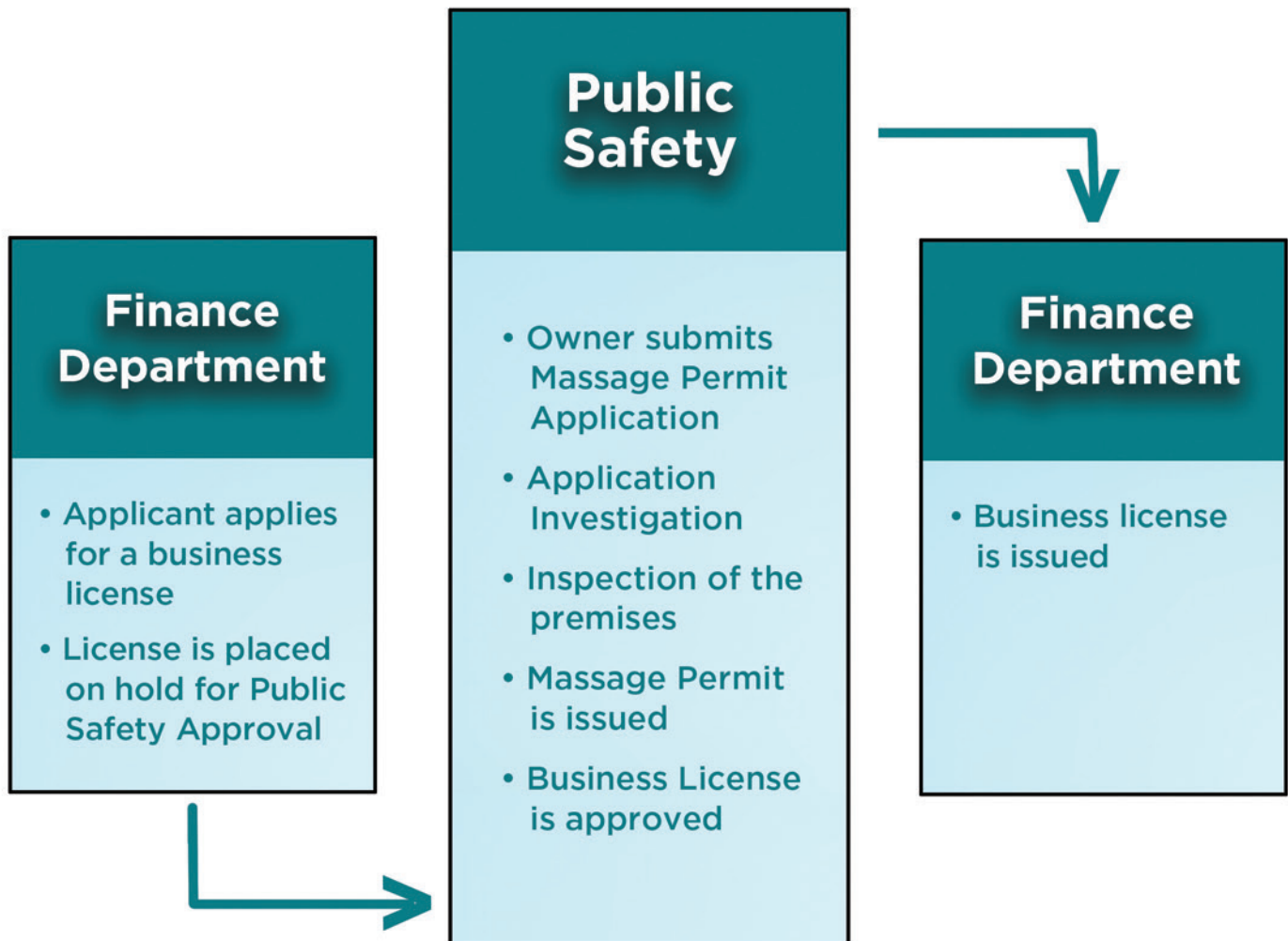

# Progressive Discipline

## Notice of Permit Denial

- Right to appeal

## Notice of Violation and Fines

- \$500 per violation
- Requires reinspection

## Notice of Violation and Proposed Suspension

- Department hearing & Decision
- Right to appeal

## Notice of Violation and Proposed Revocation

- Department hearing & Decision
- Right to appeal
- If upheld, 5-year moratorium on the premises

- Appeals are conducted by the City Manager or designee
- All discipline notices are certified and shared with CAMTC



# Outcomes

- Legitimate business owners and practitioners are supported
- Straw-man ownership is reduced
- If criminal activity is detected, an administrative hearing can remove the business from the City
- The public benefits from
  - Access to healthy, safe massage services
  - Some assurance that practitioners are properly trained and certified


